- **WHEREAS**, accepting a donation from Project Beloved.org in the amount of \$2,564 for the remodel of the Victim Interview Room and the creation of a emotionally safe place for the interview of victims and family members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

- <u>Section 1:</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents, authorizing accepting the donation from Project Beloved.org in the amount of \$2,564 for the remodel of the Victim Interview Room and the creation of an emotionally safe place for the interview of victims and family members.
- **Section 2:** All orders, ordinances, and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.
- **Section 3:** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and it is so resolved.

Creating a space that is comfortable rather than stark allows the participant to feel physically and emotionally safe and can have a significant impact on the interview process. Soft interview rooms can also be useful when interviewing those suspected of committing crimes as well.
