

RESOLUTION NO. R-2017-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS APPROVING A PROPOSAL FOR DESIGN SERVICES – FISHERMAN’S PARK IMPROVEMENTS WITH BURDITT LAND/PLACE TO DESIGN OF PARK IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING A WHEELED SPORTS PLAZA AND OTHER ASSOCIATED IMPROVEMENTS AT FISHERMAN’S PARK, 1200 WILLOW STREET, BASTROP, TEXAS, AS ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT A; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council has appointed the City Manager as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City; and

WHEREAS, The City Manager is responsible for the proper administration of all affairs of the City; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bastrop has an interest in maintaining the Parks of Bastrop and;

WHEREAS, On January 28, 2014, the Bastrop City Council received a recommendation from the Parks Board for the location of the wheeled sports plaza to be located within Fisherman’s Park; and

WHEREAS, The City Council recognizes the importance of providing recreational opportunities in perpetuity on behalf of the citizens of the city of Bastrop.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:


Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Proposal for Design Services – Fisherman’s Park Improvements with Burditt Land/Place to design of park improvements, including a wheeled sports plaza and other associated improvements at Fisherman’s Park, 1200 Willow Street, Bastrop, Texas, as attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2: All orders, ordinances, and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and it is so resolved.
