

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS APPROVING EXPENDITURE OF CITY FUNDS FOR MAYOR LYLE NELSON TO ATTEND AN EVENT, FUNCTION, AND/OR CONVENTION; PROVIDING FOR EXECUTION OF ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City of Bastrop ("City") has general authority to adopt an ordinance, resolution, or police regulation that is for the good government, peace, or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution No. R-2024-49 approving the policy of the City of Bastrop stating no city funds shall be expended for the mayor's attendance at any event, function, or convention without prior approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that adoption of this Resolution is in the interest of the general health, safety, welfare, and morals of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Bastrop, Texas, and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Bastrop approves the following Expenditures and actions for Mayor Lyle Nelson:

- Registration for the TML Annual Conference this is the 112th annual Texas Municipal League conference. This conference is traditionally attended by the Mayor and Council. The 2024 conference will be held October 9-11, 2024, in Houston, TX.
- Chamber Lunches are held the first Wednesday of each month at the Bastrop Convention Center.
- BEST breakfasts are held the last Friday of each month. The participants are from Bastrop, Elgin, and Smithville.

Section 3. Execution: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to authorize the aforementioned expenditures.

Section 4. Repealer: To the extent reasonably possible, resolutions are to be read together in harmony. However, all resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated.

Section 5. Severability: Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections, or parts of this Resolution be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Resolution.

Section 6. Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect upon the date of final passage noted below.

Section 7. Proper Notice & Meeting: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
