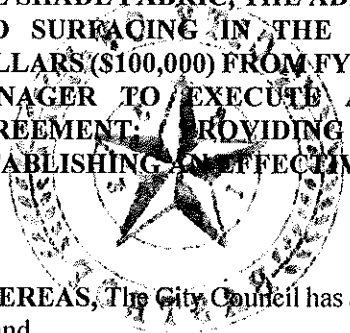


ORDINANCE NO. 2024-43

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS APPROVING THE FUNDING OF THE BOB BRYANT PLAYGROUND RENOVATIONS INCLUDING THE PLAYSCAPE STRUCTURE, REPLACING THE SHADE FABRIC, THE ADDITION OF A SWING FEATURE WITH SHADE, AND SURFACING IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM FY25 FUND BALANCE. AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.



WHEREAS, The City Council has appointed the City Manager as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City; and

WHEREAS, The City Manager is responsible for the proper administration of all affairs of the City; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bastrop has an interest in providing safe, interactive play areas for community children and families; and

WHEREAS, The City Parks and Recreation Department strives to provide quality experiences in our parks; and

WHEREAS, Renovating Bob Bryant Park Playground area will create a safer, more creative atmosphere for growth and play for the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents, to direct finance to authorize needed funding not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000)


