



# Certification of No Impact

**To: City of Bastrop**  
**Re: Certification of No Impact**

The temporary moratorium approved by Bastrop City Council on August 14, 2018 prohibits permit applications from being accepted unless the project qualifies for an Exception or Exemption. One of the Exception options is for projects classified as “No Impact Projects”. To qualify as a “No Impact Project”, the applicant must certify that the project will not: (a) increase density, (b) increase or impact impervious cover, (c) expand the footprint of an existing structure, or (d) alter the current drainage pattern on the property.

To be issued a permit under the moratorium, an application, this letter, and the associated checklist items must be submitted, reviewed, and approved.

By signing this letter, you are hereby certifying as the permit applicant, you have personally evaluated the project site, considered the nature and scope of the project, and concluded that the project described on the associated application **will not**:

- Increase density;
- Increase or impact impervious cover;
- Expand the footprint of an existing structure; or
- Alter the current drainage pattern on the property.
